

Q Up to the time that your mother went to China, did anybody, other than you and your parents, live on the third floor at 929 Grant Ave.?

A No one else.

Q Can you speak English?

A Very little.

Q How long have you been connected with your present business? A Two years.

Q At the age of 16 or 17, when you say you were able old enough to take care of yourself, what occupation did you have?

A I started to work in the Dai Sang Tong Co., filling prescriptions and acting as salesman.

Q Where was this company located when you first went to work for them?

A 929 Grant Avenue.

Q Did you first work for that firm as an employee, or as a partner?

A As a partner.

Q What interest did you have? A \$1000.00.

Q How did you acquire that interest? A My father gave me this interest of \$1000. - his interest - when he went back to China.

Q How long did you continue as a member of Dai Sang Tong Company?

A From the time I was 17 years old until 1906.

Q Upon leaving Oakland, after your year's residence there, following the earthquake, where did you go?

A I then became a member of Him Sing Chong company, 1001 Grant Ave., San Francisco.

Q Have you been actively engaged in that company, ever since, about, 1907?

A I stayed there until C.R. 15 (1926) and then I became interested in the Yuen Tang Co., which are located in the Him Sing Chung Co.

Q Are there any persons, other than Jeong Woon and Chew Chung Tak, now in the United States, who know you to have been born in San Francisco?

A I do not recall the names of any particular persons; there are some other persons who know I was born in this country.

Q How old was Jeong Woon, when you first met him? A I have known him ever since I was a child; he was about 20 years old.

Q How old is he now? A 70-odd years old.

Q How old was Chew Chung Tak when you first knew him? A About the same age.

Q What were the occupations of these men when you first knew them?

A When I knew them as a child, Jeong Woon was working in my father's store; and Chew Chung Tak was delivering goods for Gwong Wing Chung Company.

Q Did Jeong Woon continue as a member of the Dai Chung Tong Co., after it moved to Jackson Street? - No. 718?

A No.

Q When did he withdraw from that firm? A He left the firm when I was 5 or 6 years old.

Q Then what did he do? A I think he went to work, but I remember him having worked at the Far Yuen Chung Co., on Clay Street, a Chinese grocery store, but I do not know whether or not he was a partner.

Q Did Chew Chung Tak continue delivering goods at the Dai Chung Tong Co., after it moved to 718 Jackson Street? A No.

Q What was he doing after your store moved there?

A I do not know, but I think he worked in an American family.
