

STATEMENT OF WITNESS:

Sworn and admonished that if at any time he fails to understand the interpreter to immediately so state and is advised of the nature of and the penalty for the crime of perjury. Speaks Hoi Ping dialect.

- Q What are all your names, age and birth place? A Jung "oon and Jung Ping Ngaw, no others; age 74 yrs.; born in China.
- Q When did you first come to the U.S.? A KS 1(1875).
- Q Have you made any trips to China? A No.
- Q Have you ever testified in a Chinese case? A Yes.
- Q Have you a Certificate of Residence? A I used to have one but it was burned in the Earthquake of 1906 in San Francisco.
- Q Do you know the number of it? A No.
- Q Did you never apply for a duplicate? A No, because the time I lost that Certificate of Residence I was 50 odd yrs. old so I did not apply for one.
- Q Have you ever married? A Yes, once only.
- Q When, where and whom did you marry? A TC 12(1873), in China, to Woo Shee.
- Q Are you the father of any children? A Yes, three sons, no daughters.
- Q Did your wife or either of your sons ever come to the United States? A Yes, all my sons were born in the U.S.
- Q When did your wife come to the United States? A In either KS 8 or 9 (1882 or 1883).
- Q Is your wife still living? A No, she died 10 years ago in San Francisco.
- Q Have your sons made trips to China? A Only my last son Jung Jook Keung has made one trip to China.
- Q Did he go on a Form 430? A Yes.
- Q Did you testify for him when he was an applicant? A Yes.
- Q Has he returned to the U.S.? A Yes, he is at present in the United States.
- Q On what ship did he last arrive from China? A I do not know the name of the steamer but it was a Japanese steamer - it was in CR 12- it was the latter part of year.
- Q Is that the only trip he made to China? A Yes.
- Q When did he sail? A The 1st part of CR 12, on the "Pres. Taft".
- Q When you testified for that son, was that your first appearance before this Service as a witness? A Yes.
- Q Is that the only time you have so testified? A No, I was ^{a witness} in some other cases after that.
- Q Is Jung Jook Keung your son's record name? A Yes.
- Q For whom else have you testified? A In the case of Quan Ging or Gun in CR 11 (1922) who was arrested at Los Angeles and I came here to testify in regard to his nativity; In the cases of Jung Wah Wee and Jung Wah Gim, who are brothers applying for Form 430 in CR 14(1925); in the case of Jew Bok Heung applying for Form 430 in CR 15(1926); in the case of my nephew Jung Wah Leung, applying for Form 430 in CR 15.
