Q After Lee Leong went to China in KS 12, did he never return to the United States?

A No.

Q How long did Low Tit have custody of Lee Hee? A For about 4 or 5 years, then Low Tit went back to China.

Q Has he ever returned to the United States? A No.

Q What occupation did Low Tit have between the time of Lee Leong's departure for China and his own departure? A He was the manager of the Dai Sang Tong Co. during all that tm

Q At what number on Grant Ave. was that concern situated? A 929 Grant Ave.

Q Is that firm still in existence at that address? A No, not after the Earthquake

Q What became of Lee Hee when Low Tit went to China? A Lee Hee went to school and ate and slept in the Dai Sang Tong Co.

Q For how many years did he do that after Lee Tit's departure? A About 10 years - he went to a Chinese school and also a private English school.

Q Did he live during those 10 years at 929 Grant Ave.? A Yes.

Q Did Lee Leong's wife Fung Shee bear any other children? A No.

Q How do you know? A After the birth of the applicant I often asked Lee Leong if he had any other children and he told me "No".

Q How old was Lee Leong when he went to China last? A About 50 yrs. old.

Q Did you, a young man 30 yrs. or so his junior, ask him if he had any other children? A Yes, he was a good friend of mine.

Q Have you lived in San Francisco continuously since you first came to the United States? A No, I had worked for a few years at Bethany before the Earthquake and I had been to Los Angeles about 2 or 3 years just after the Earthquake. I also made some short trips to Stockton in recent years.

Q What was your occupation after you left the Dai Sang Tong Co.? A I did some porter work and housework in San Francisco for about 2 years.

Q Did you become associated with any mercantile pursuit? A In KS 11(1885) I became a merchant of the Wong Wing Chong Co., 769 Clay St., San Francisco.

Q Did you understand the previous Interpreter? A Yes (thru Edwar Lee.)

Q Who managed the Dai Sang Tong Co. after Lee Leong's departure for China?

A Low Tit.

Q How many stories high was the building at 929 Grant Ave.? A Three stories.

Q On which floor did Lee Leong and his wife live? A On the 3rd floor.

Q How was the second floor used? A The front part of the 2nd floor was used as a workmen's quarters; the rear part of the second floor was used for storage.

Q Was the Dai Sang Tong Co. still at that address when the Earthquake came in 1906?

A No, the Dai Sang Tong was located at Jackson St. and the corner of the Gum Gook Yuen Alley a few years before the earthquake.

Q How much of those premises did the store occupy? A Only a store space on the ground floor.

Q Did anybody except Lee Leong and his family live on the 3rd floor at 929 Grant Ave.? A No.

Q What occupation did Lee Hee first take up after Low Tit went to China?
