


- Q Was Lee Leong older or younger than you? A Lee Leong was a much older man - he was about 50 yrs. old when he went to China.
- Q How old were you when he went to China? A About 30 yrs. old.
- Q Did Lee Leong ever have a shaving feast for Lee Hay? A Yes.
- Q Did you attend it? A No, I was too busy.
- Q How do you know he had one? A I was invited to the feast at a restaurant across the street where I worked but I had to deliver goods and could not go.
- Q Did Lee Hay ever attend school? A Yes, he attended school at the so-called 5 story building on Grant Ave. or Du Pont St. He had a teacher - a Deng family man, and also an American woman who went to that building and taught English.
- Q How did you know of Lee Hay's attending school there? A I saw him go to that building and I asked him why he went there and he told me he went to school.
- Q Do you know if Lee Hay registered in KS 20? A Yes.
- Q How do you know it? A I went and registered and I asked hi, if he went to register or not - he told me he did and I told him it wasn't really necessary for him to go because he was a merchant's son.
- Q Did you ever see his Certificate of Residence? A Yes.
- Q Who is that? (Showing photo of other witness). A Jung Woon.
- Q Do you know whom this photograph represents? (Showing photo of applicant on his departure paper of 1898). A That looks somewhat like Lee Hay.
- NOTE: Witness identifies photograph of applicant on his Form 430.
- Q Is Lee Hay married? A Yes. He has two sons and one daughter.
- Q Did you ever see his children? A I have seen his two sons but not his daughter.
- Q Why is that? A The girl has never come over from China while his sons did.
- Q Have you any further statement to make? A No.
- Q Have you understood the Interpreter? A Yes (in English).
